Divisions:

WAG & MAG Levels 3-10 Individual & Team Competition

- WAG Teams: Maximum of 5 gymnasts per team, with a maximum of 5 gymnasts to compete on each apparatus with the top 3 scores to count towards the team total.
- MAG Teams: Teams will be a minimum of 3 scores to count, no maximum number of athletes per team.
- WAG Team Divisions: Level 3, Level 4, Level 5 & 6, Level 7, Level 8-10 combined
- MAG Team Divisions: Level 3-5 Combined and Level 6-10 combined
- WAG & MAG Overall Club: Top team score per division added together to calculate Overall Club Total
- Pre-Junior WAG & MAG: Level 1, 2 & Pre 3 will run as a bump on event.

Routine Requirements:

WAG Pre-Levels (we will accommodate for your clubs own pre level routines, routines will need to be submitted with your nomination forms.) WAG ALP Version 3.2 Released in 2022. FIG 2022-2024 Code of Points, MAG ALP 2022-2025 Version 1.1 Released in January 2022, with Qld amendments.

Competition Rules/Regulations & Divisions:

Rules & Regulations as per current GQ GymSports Regulations. We reserve the right to combine divisions where there are insufficient competitors to have both under and over divisions.

Levels Testing:

Each club is to nominate on the competition entry form, which gymnasts will be levels testing.

Entries:

Late entries are permitted up to 3 working days after close of entries, but will incur a 25% late fee. Entries will not be accepted after this point. Nominations will not be accepted without payment of nomination fees. Bank Details are on the nomination form if required. If paying via direct debit, please attach confirmation of payment with nomination forms. All gymnasts, judges and coaches must be registered with Gymnastics Queensland at the time the nomination form is received. A \$20 fee will be incurred for each non-registered athlete, coach or judge. Should all details on the entry form not be completed then the entry form will be returned and a late entry fee applied, if amended form is received after the due date.

Provisions of Judges:

Clubs with gymnasts competing in levels 3-10 must nominate an appropriately qualified judge per session on the Entry Form. Failure to do so may result in a \$200 proxy fine. *Minimum supplying of Judges for WAG clubs, if a club has more than 15 gymnasts in a division of a level (or level, if there are no divisions), the club will be required to provide (2) judges for all the sessions of that division or level. Minimum supplying of Judges for MAG clubs, if a club has 1-7 athletes in a session, clubs are required to supply (1) judge, 8-14 Athletes (2) judges and 15+ Athletes (3) judges.*

Awards:

- Level 1, 2 & Pre Levels Certificate with individual apparatus execution deductions with matching ribbon, on each apparatus for all gymnasts based on performance standard. All around finisher medal for each gymnast.
- Levels 3-10 Trophies 1st to 3rd Individual All Around, Medals 1st to 3rd Individual Apparatus & Ribbons 4th to 6th All Around & Apparatus (*for divisions with 10 or more competitors*). Medals 1st to 3rd Team All Around & Team Apparatus per division & Overall Club.

Coach & Judge Accreditation:

All coaches & judges need to have a current GA Technical registration to be permitted on the competition floor and have been nominated on the club's entry form. All coaches & judges must present a physical copy of their current working with children check (Blue Card) & sign in each day prior to warm up/start time.

Withdrawals & Refunds:

A refund (less 20%) will be made on receipt of a medical certificate up to 2 weeks after the event. No refund of the entry fee will be given to any withdrawals without a medical certificate. No exceptions to this policy will be considered. All requests are to be emailed through to fun@mareebagymnastics.org.au.

Spectators:

Spectator entry will be via a Gold Coin Donation. Nominated gymnasts, coaches, judges and official volunteers will be admitted free.

Canteen:
